

# Admitted with Transfer Credits?

---

It is very important that you understand how your transfer credits will apply to your degree.

If you are selecting courses prior to receiving your transfer credit assessment, do not enrol in any courses which duplicate the courses for which you might be granted transfer credits.

Make sure to submit your final transcript or official results. Transfer credits cannot be finalized without official documentation.

## Transfer Credit Quick Facts:

- Appear on your U of T transcript.
- Do not count in GPAs.
- Count towards degree requirements (some limitations apply).
- May count towards specialist, major or minor programs of study.
- May fulfill course pre-requisites and breadth requirements.
