 - *There is ONE application for both roles, with the option to apply for one or both*

- ✓ Include an unofficial transcript/academic record of your marks. You may download this from ACORN– please ensure your name is on the PDF.

- ✓ Include a current resume/curriculum vitae.

- ✓ Include two reference contacts.

- ✓ Successful Candidates will be invited sign up for one of the Interview Carousels taking place February 15th – 19th 2021. Candidates are invited to register in advance and will be notified by e-mail. Attendance is mandatory. Failure to attend a Don Carousel will void your application.

- ✓ Successful candidates from Carousel Interviews will proceed to a personal interview which will be held between March 1st and March 12th, 2021.
